

Game Events 2025

May 20: Mutt & Jeff - combined low scores on par 3s and 5.

May 27: Count Only Even Holes - low team score wins

June 3: Hit Fairways and Greens - for every drive that lands on the fairway, your team gets 5 points. That will include the par 3s. Subtract all putts from points earned on each hole. Zero is the lowest score you can get on a single hole; do not go into negative numbers.

June 10: Cha Cha Cha - on holes 1, 4, & 7 (cha), the lowest score counts as the team score. On holes 2, 5, & 8 (cha, cha), two lowest scores combined count as the team score. On holes 3, 6, & 9 (cha, cha, cha), three lowest scores combined count as the team score.

June 17: Team Low Putts - team score. The name is self-explanatory.

June 24: Lunch Meeting/Guest Day - 9 hole scramble on back 9. With a scramble, everyone hits a ball off the tee box. The best ball is selected by the team. Each player plays best ball, low team score wins.

July 1: Best Poker Hand - individual event, self-explanatory. Note: this follows poker rules, so it is best of 5. Ex: can't have more than 4 of a kind.

July 8: Par 4 the Course - combined lowest score on par 4s.

July 15: Count only odd holes - low team score wins (1,3,5,7,9)

July 22: Sunday Funday on a Tuesday, Back 9 Decade Day! - wear your favorite decade outfit. Prizes on every hole, so come join the FUN.

July 29: O-N-E-S - best team score on holes with those letters (1,6,7,8,9)

August 5: 3-club Event - individual event. Each member can only bring 3 clubs plus a putter. The lowest individual score wins.

August 12: Pink Ball - decide among your foursome in what order you will tee off. Write names in that order on your scorecard. Player 1 tees off with the pink ball on hole 1 and plays the ball on entire hole. Her score is entered next to her name on the scorecard AND as Pinkie's score. Player 2 tees off with the pink ball on hole 2, player 3 tees off with pink ball on hole 3, player 4 tees off with the pink ball on hole 5, then you start the rotation over with player 1 on hole 5, etc. The team with the lowest score for Pinkie wins. Any team that loses the pink ball during the round is out of the money. If all pink balls are lost, the team that kept theirs longest wins.

August 19: Lunch Meeting - 9 hole scramble BACK 9. Follow rules for Scramble play outlined above (June 24).
