2025 NCC Ladies Golf League Rules

- 1. Observe good golf etiquette. Keep pace with the group ahead of you.
- 2. One ball in the water or swamp: carry to the other side and take a one stroke penalty.
- 3. If you use an "old" ball over the water or swamp, you may change balls with no penalty.
- 4. Lost ball: play next ball as close as possible to point of entry and add one stroke. Player may choose to hit a provisional ball from where the original ball was hit. She must inform her group and add one stroke. If the first ball is playable, she must play that ball.
- 5. Unplayable ball (next to tree or bush): you may move the ball two club lengths NOT nearer the green and add one stroke. When a ball is hit near a new tree, you get a free lift. If it is in the rough, it must be played from the rough.
- 6. Unnatural Hazard if a ball lands next to a hose, sprinkler, pool of water on fairway, or ground under construction, you may move two club lengths NOT nearer the green. No penalty.
- 7. Do not "ground" your club in a sand trap. Penalty is one stroke for grounding.
- 8. Cleaning of the golf ball may be done on the green after you mark the ball. The ball may be lifted or cleaned on the fairway.
