Job Description: The primary role of the Golf Marshall is to provide a great golfing experience for every guest via excellent customer service, while also maintaining a good pace of play. In addition, the Marshall will assist starting golfers on time and informing them of the round expectations.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Identify slow groups and maintain a reasonable pace of play
- Ensure that all guests are adhering to course rules and golf etiquette
- Monitor the course at all times by moving around the entire grounds
- Constantly patrol course looking for ways to assist guests
- Perform reasonable tasks and projects as assigned by the Head Pro/Manager, Superintendent, or Assistant Manager
- Communication with the Pro Shop about pace and play problems

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to drive a golf cart
- Prolonged periods of standing, sitting, or walking

Minimum Job Requirements:

- Able to work flexible hours and holidays
- General knowledge of golf course and golf etiquette
- Excellent customer service
- At least 18 years of age
